

Lighthouse - Byron Bay - NSW

Cape Byron Lighthouse (operational 1901) stands on the most easterly point of the Australian mainland and is Australia's most easterly lighthouse. It is constructed of prefabricated concrete blocks. The road to the light is signposted from the township, parking can be at a premium in Summer, and also cost \$7.00. Free parking is available 200 metres from the top, or a little more distance back down the one way 'down' road. The doe goat (below) is the last resident goat (Summer 2010) of a much larger flock now relocated.
