



# LITTLE SANDHILLS MORETON ISLAND

The Little Sandhills on Moreton are two kilometres wide, coast to coast, and consist of three dune lines that get higher towards the eastern ocean side. The above photograph is the second dune going east, and below, the third dune.

A line of vegetation grows behind each dune. Walkers usually cross through breaks in the vegetation on the northern end of each dune, which also puts the walker on the highest point of each dune, for the view.

The lower sandy area on the following page is the Little Sandhills, and the vegetation visible in the photographs on this page, is the dark line in the lee of each dune in the satellite photograph.
